SUBJECT: Hayward Youth Commission: Adopt a Resolution Confirming the Appointment

and Reappointment of Hayward Youth Commission Members

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council adopts a resolution (Attachment II) confirming the appointment to the Hayward Youth Commission of ten (10) voting members and eleven (11) alternate members, and the reappointment of six (6) continuing members.

SUMMARY

The City conducted its annual recruitment for the Hayward Youth Commission (HYC) between March 9, 2023, and May 19, 2023, and a panel of representatives from the three local agencies (City of Hayward, Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (HARD), and the Hayward Unified School District (HUSD)) reviewed fifty-nine (59) applications and interviewed forty-nine (49) eligible applicants on June 1, 2023. The panel selected a total of twenty-one (21) regular voting and alternate members. The same panel confirmed the reappointment of six (6) current members.

BACKGROUND

On June 1, 2023, an interview panel comprised of representatives from the three local public agencies (City of Hayward, HARD, and HUSD) interviewed forty-nine candidates to fill vacancies on the HYC. The agency representatives were: Council Member Ray Bonilla Jr. from the City of Hayward; Board President Rick Hatcher and Board Director Sara Lamnin from HARD; and Board Secretary Joe Ramos and Board Trustee Sara Prada from HUSD.




