1. Approval of Meeting Minutes from November 1, 2023

- 2. American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding: Analysis and Review of Current and Planned Expenditures

 - B. Can ARPA funds be used to replenish the General Fund Reserve?
 - C. Why did funds double for the potential Safe Parking Pilot program versus what was initially presented?
 - D. Would the loans issued from the potential Affordable Housing Development project be paid back?
 - E. Does the potential Exterior Video Surveillance Cameras-City Hall and Weekes Branch Library project include the Watkins garage? If not, can the project be amended to add the garage?
 - F. What is the total potential reallocation amount of unobligated ARPA funds?
 - G. Does potential projection prioritization occur during Council Budget and Finance Committee or the full Council?

 - A. Are any of the "address negative economic impacts caused by the public health emergency" funds available for reallocation?
 - B. How much is the true cost of the potential Safe Parking program?
 - C. How is the cost determined for the potential Motel Vouchers program?
 - D. What are the next steps regarding the allocation of unobligated ARPA funds?
 - E. Will Council get to choose the potential projects to fund if there are unobligated ARPA funds?
