SUBJECT Approval of Resolution Authorizing the Co-Executive Directors to Negotiate and Execute a Contract with Cameron Moberg for Maintenance and Repairs to the Tennyson Soundwall Mural

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board approves the attached resolution (Attachment II), authorizing the Co-Executive Directors to negotiate and execute a contract with Cameron Moberg for maintenance and repairs of the Tennyson Soundwall Mural.

BACKGROUND

The Authority Board approved resolutions authorizing the completion of five murals throughout the JPA boundaries at its March 21, 2016 meeting. The Tennyson Soundwall mural was completed later that year.

DISCUSSION

Unfortunately, due to this winter's weather, the Tennyson Soundwall which housed the Sister City Mural by artist Cameron Moberg, had a portion of the wall collapse which required being reconstructed. The portion of the wall has now been reconstructed but requires the mural to be repaired/repainted.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of this repair work will not exceed \$2,500 and will be funded out of the contingency balance appropriated in the FY2017 authority operating budget.

NEXT STEPS

Following adoption of the attached resolution, the co-executive directors will execute an agreement with Cameron Moberg to complete this repair work immediately.
