## HAYWARD EXECUTIVE AIRPORT HANGAR RENTAL RATES

The Airport is operated as an enterprise fund and relies solely upon the revenues it generates to fund operating and capital improvement budgets. A part of Airport revenue is funded from rents received from hangars tenants. Hangar rents are reviewed and, if necessary, adjusted periodically.

Staff is proposing to set pre-determined percentage increases of up to 10% per year for various hangar sizes for the next four (4) years, beginning April 1, 2019.
