RESOLUTION DISSOLVING THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, the Downtown Business Improvement Area (DBIA) was established by the City Council in 1985 to promote the economic revitalization and physical improvement of the downtown business district; and

WHEREAS, state law required the appointment of an advisory board whose role is to make recommendations to the City Council regarding expenditure of assessment revenue and method and basis of levying the assessments; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Business Improvement Area Advisory Board was established by the City Council to serve that statutory function; and

WHEREAS, since 2016 assessment fees leveraged against downtown businesses were discontinued and the Board has been spending down reserves on downtown events, sidewalk cleanings and marketing materials; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2019, at a Regular Meeting a motion was made, and Board members approved, to recommend to City Council the dissolution of the Board; and

WHEREAS, there is no fiscal or economic impact associated with the dissolution of the DBIA Advisory Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the Downtown Business Improvement Area Advisory Board is hereby dissolved.
