RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CONSOLIDATED ENGINEERING LABORATORIES FOR MATERIALS TESTING AND SPECIAL INSPECTION SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE FIRE STATION 6 AND FIRE TRAINING CENTER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2019, Council adopted a resolution approving the plans and specifications and call for bids for the Fire Station 6 and Fire Training Center Project, pending approval from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the Division of the State Architect (DSA); and

WHEREAS, the construction of Fire Station 6 and the Fire Training Center requires materials testing and special inspection services to ensure that the materials and construction comply with project plans, specifications and codes, and such testing is required by the DSA for buildings owned by the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, which is the City's partner in this project. .

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute, on behalf of the City of Hayward, an agreement with Consolidated Engineering Laboratories for Materials Testing and Special Inspection services, in an amount not-to-exceed \$350,000 associated with the Fire Station 6 and the Fire Training Center, in a form approved by the City Attorney.
