### **RECOMMENDATION**

That Council adopts a resolution (Attachment II) reappointing Council Member Márquez as the City of Hayward representative to the Alameda County Mosquito Abatement District Board of Trustees for the next four-year term from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2024.

### **SUMMARY**

Council Member Márquez has been serving as the City of Hayward's representative to the Alameda County Mosquito Abatement District Board of Trustees since March 17, 2015, and the Board is requesting her reappointment to a four-year term ending December 31, 2024.

### **BACKGROUND**

Council Member Márquez has been serving on the Alameda County Mosquito Abatement District Board of Trustees since March 17, 2015.

The Alameda County Mosquito Abatement District requests the reappointment of Council Member Márquez to the Alameda County Mosquito Abatement District Board of Trustees representing the City of Hayward for four years from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2024. Council Member Márquez currently serves on the Board of Trustees and has expressed interest in continuing to serve on this Board.
