RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$774,900 IN AWARDED GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR PROJECT 05737 SIGNAL MODIFICATION AT HUNTWOOD/INDUSTRIAL AND HUNTWOOD/SANDOVAL

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) is awarding the City of Hayward (City) a \$774,900 grant for the signal modification at Huntwood/Industrial and Huntwood/Sandoval intersections; and

WHEREAS, the project has an appropriated budget of \$965,000 from the City's Transportation System Improvement Fund (Fund 460) through the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget process, which includes \$774,000 from the HSIP grant for 90% of the construction cost combined with the 10% local-match requirement of \$86,100 for a total construction cost of \$861,000. The remaining \$104,000 in the total project cost is for engineering design service and staff costs; and

WHEREAS, this item was already approved by the City Grant Committee in January 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept and appropriate grant funding from the Federal Highway Safety Program in the amount of \$774,900 for Project 05737 Signal Modification at Huntwood/Industrial and Huntwood/Sandoval.
