RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO (1) ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE ALAMEDA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$162,000, AND (2) APPROPRIATE A TOTAL OF \$324,000 FROM MEASURE BB LOCAL TRANSPORTATION (FUND 212) FUND BALANCE FOR PROJECT 05319: SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL (SR2S) PROGRAM FOR CESAR CHAVEZ MIDDLE SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Transportation Commission (ACTC) is awarding the City of Hayward (City) a \$162,000 grant, which is 50% of the estimated project cost for the Safe Route to School project for Cesar Chaves Middle School, and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a 50% local-match made by the City which will include the design, staff costs, construction management and a share of the construction cost, and

WHEREAS, the City has available funds in Measure BB – Local Transportation Fund (Fund 212) for a total project cost of \$324,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to accept and appropriate funding from ACTC in the amount of \$162,000 and appropriates a total of \$324,000 from the fund balance for Project 05319: SR2S Program – Cesar Chavez Middle School.
