RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ITERIS, INC., TO PROCURE THE VIDEO DETECTION SYSTEM FOR THE SYDNEY COORDINATED ADAPTIVE TRAFFIC SYSTEM (SCATS) FOR SEVERAL INTERSECTIONS ON JACKSON STREET AND WEST WINTON AVENUE IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$130,000

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward intends to incorporate SCATS to five signalized intersections – Jackson Street at Cypress Avenue/Amador Street, Soto Road, Grand Street, Silva Avenue/Meek Avenue and West Winton Avenue at Saklan Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward sent Requests for Proposals to electrical contractors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward received one cost proposal in the amount of \$298,815; and

WHEREAS, due to the high-cost proposal, the Request for Proposal was broken-up to separate procurement of the SCATS video detection equipment from the work to install the equipment; and

WHEREAS, cost proposals were received for the installation and a contract was executed with DC Electric in the amount of \$116,500 to provide the installation services; and

WHEREAS, cost proposals for the SCATS video detection equipment were received ranging from \$130,000 to \$141,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Hayward, a contract with Iteris, Inc to procure the equipment for the video detection system, in an amount not-to-exceed \$130,000, in a form approved by the City Attorney.
