RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH REDSKY EMERGENCY VEHICLES TO PURCHASE TWO (2) TYPE 1 AMBULANCES FOR THE MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTH UNIT

WHEREAS, the City Council directed staff to develop a mobile mental health response team per the recommendation by the Public Safety Policy Innovation Workshop on May 18, 2021, including authorizing funding for vehicle acquisition; and

WHEREAS, the Hayward Evaluation and Response Team (HEART) will serve community members experiencing mental illness, substance abuse, and homelessness by linking them with services and reducing the need for police intervention; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward intends to purchase the two (2) Type 1 ambulances from RedSky Emergency Vehicles for \$435,875.59; and

WHEREAS, the ambulance purchases will provide HEART with transport and treatment capabilities for community members in need of care.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hayward hereby adopts this resolution and authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with RedSky Emergency Vehicles to purchase two (2) Type 1 ambulances.
