Commercial Cannabis Program: Introduce Two Ordinances Related to Text Amendments to Chapter 6, Article 14 (Commercial Cannabis Businesses) and Chapter 10 (Planning, Zoning, and Subdivisions) of the Hayward Municipal Code for the Regulation of Personal and Commercial Cannabis (Application No. 202102446) and Adopt Two Resolutions Supporting the Proposed Text Amendments and Approving a Revision to the 2022 Master Fee Schedule for Administration and Enforcement of the Commercial Cannabis Program in the City of Hayward (Report from Assistant City Manager/Development Services Director Ott)

A motion was made by Council Member Wahab, seconded by Council Member Zermeño, to approve staff's recommendation with five friendly amendments: 1) increase the buffer from schools to 1,000 foot; 2) add the two Planning Commission recommendations to Chapter 6 (Business, Trades and Professional) and Chapter 10 (Planning, Zoning and Subdivision) regarding the regulation of commercial cannabis business; 3) set the maximum limitation applied to business to consumer retail storefronts to a maximum square footage of 1,000 square feet or up to 10% of the first 10,000 square foot, whichever is less; 4) add Adopt a Block; and 5) add public art as an option for the Community Benefit plan. The motion carried by the following vote:
