RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$300,000 IN HIGHWAY-RAILWAY CROSSING SAFETY PROGRAM (SECTION 130) FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING PHASE OF THE TENNYSON ROAD CROSSING SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 06944 AND EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 2

WHEREAS, the Tennyson Road at-grade rail crossing was identified for funding of safety improvements through the Federal Section 130 Program funds distributed by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans); and

WHEREAS, The Section 130 program is a federally funded program administered by the States for the elimination of hazards at highway-rail at-grade crossings; and

WHEREAS, On January 23, 2024, Council approved a resolution authorizing the City Manager to accept and appropriate \$506,242.46 in Section 130 Program funding for the Preliminary Engineering (PE) Phase of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded an additional \$300,000 in Section 130 Program funding for the PE phase of the project; and

WHEREAS, there will be no impact to the General Fund or Measure C, as all project expenses will be fully reimbursed through the Federal Railway-Highway Crossings (Section 130) grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby finds and determines as follows that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Amendment No. 2 of the Section 130 Program funding agreement with Caltrans subject to approval by City Attorney as to form to increase by \$300,000, for a total funding amount of \$806,242.46, for the PE phase of Project No. 06944, Tennyson Road Crossing Safety Improvement.
