SUBJECT: Proposed 2026-2027 Agenda Planning Calendar: Review and Comment

RECOMMENDATION

That the Council Public Safety Committee (CPSC) reviews and comments on this report.

SUMMARY

The proposed 2026-2027 agenda planning calendar contains tentative agenda topics for future CPSC meetings for the Committee’s consideration. This item will remain on future CPSC agendas and will be updated periodically to reflect any modifications to the planning calendar, including additions, rescheduled items, cancelled items, and confirmed meeting dates.

BACKGROUND

At the March 24, 2026 City Council meeting, Resolution No. 26-104 was adopted to reduce the Council Public Safety Committee meeting from bi-monthly to quarterly. Staff is currently evaluating potential meeting schedules that avoid conflicts with holidays, standing City meetings, and other operational constraints. Each CPSC meeting will begin with oral reports from the Fire and Police Chiefs, including incident data, summaries of major incidents or trends, and upcoming public safety initiatives or events.

In addition to the Chief Reports, staff suggests the following tentative agenda topics for the Committee’s consideration during the 2026-2027 calendar cycle.


NEXT STEPS
