RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A LANDSCAPE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT FOR CALTRANS SURPLUS PROPERTY WEED ABATEMENT WITH JOE'S LANDSCAPE AND CONCRETE, INC. WITH A MAXIMUM COMPENSATION NOT-TO-EXCEED \$700,000

WHEREAS, the Landscape Maintenance Division is responsible for maintaining trees and municipal landscape throughout the City along with vegetation management; and

WHEREAS, vegetation management services are necessary to mitigate fire hazards by completing weed abatement activities, reduce fire fuel materials, and creating fire breaks and other fire defensible spaces; and

WHEREAS, in November 2025, staff released a Request for Quote (RFQ) 26-013 that detailed landscape maintenance required for the CalTrans Surplus Properties; and

WHEREAS, staff received and evaluated five (5) bids with one important criteria of finishing the work within eight weeks; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding the contract to Joe's Landscape and Concrete, Inc, (Joe's Landscape), the most responsive bidder, in an annual amount of \$119,000, subject to CPI increases; and

WHEREAS, this contract will be funded through Fund 411 and has no impact to the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a landscape management contract for CalTrans Surplus Properties Joe's Landscape and Concrete with a maximum compensation not-to-exceed \$700,000 and a contract termination date of June 30, 2030.
